SUBJECT: GENERAL SAFETY

SCOPE: ALL EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS

PURPOSE:

The safety of our employees and guests on company premises is of major importance. The purpose of this policy, and the specific accompanying safety policies in this section are to ensure the safety of our employees, patients, clients and visitors.

POLICY:

For your protection, the company must enforce all safety rules and regulations. It is the responsibility of each employee to know and adhere to all procedures and rules contained in the company's safety publications and all other procedures and rules whether imposed by Federal or State Law, or given verbally by the company. Employees must obey all safety rules. Violation of any of the rules will result in disciplinary action up to and including discharge. Specific safety practices are outlined in the specific policy dealing with that subject. These include, but are not limited to:

- Airborne Pathogens
- Bloodborne Pathogens
- Vehicle Operations
- MSDS/ Right to Know
- Weapons
- Proper lifting
- Scene Safety
- Lockout/ Tag out
- Severe weather procedures
- Other topics identified in company policies and procedures

Employees will report unsafe working conditions, accidents resulting in injury or damage to company property, work related illness or injuries to a supervisor immediately upon identifying there is an issue.
